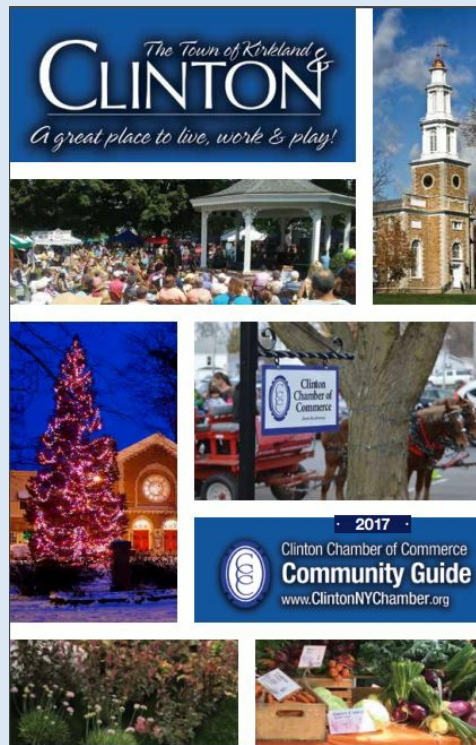

2018 Community Guide Deadline - Friday, February 2nd

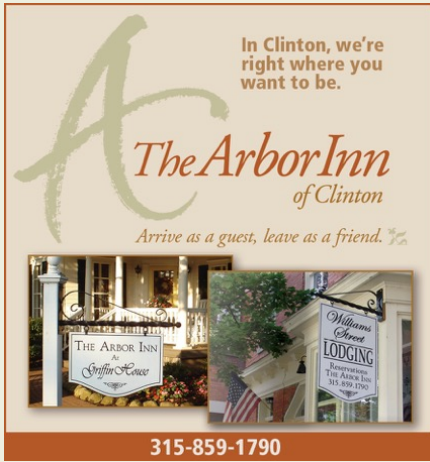
